WHAT ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

The Haven has collecting tins placed both in Wolverhampton city centre and surrounding areas. We are ideally seeking a volunteer with a car but, where not available, a volunteer with access to public transport into the city centre could focus on tins in this area.

We are seeking someone to support once or twice per month, but are able to discuss alternative arrangements to suit your needs.

There is the opportunity to have greater involvement by supporting the processing of income once the tins have been collected, dependent on the aspirations of each volunteer.
